We serve students at our two locations, Chapel Street and Oxford Drive.










🎾 OF STUDENTS SERVED LIVE BELOW FEDERAL POVERTY LINE

When homework seems hard, having a dedicated volunteer makes all the difference.




Working out fractions. Students have access to everything from white boards to computers to help learn new math.





A generous grant from the Redlands Art Association provides exposure to different artistic mediums and local artists. Students helped design and paint this mural for our Oxford location library.




Students increase their skills and confidence each year thru participation in the world renown Redlands Bicycle Classic.






